Seniors must pay \$50 to South Hamilton for their cap and gown, flower, and diploma. This fee must be paid by April 1, 2021. Students and/or parents can pay either cash or check in the superintendent's office or pay through Infinite Campus.

FEBRUARY CHECKLIST FOR SENIORS

- Confirm that the colleges to which you have applied have received all of the necessary documents needed (transcripts, recommendations, test scores, etc.)
- Submit your FAFSA if you haven't already done so.
- Begin making plans for a summer job.
- Watch the mail for letters of acceptance.
- Keep your grades up – second semester grades are important and can affect scholarship eligibility and college admittance.
- Continue to apply for as many scholarships as possible. Fastweb and Going Merry are great databases.
- Look weekly for scholarship updates on the scholarship website.
- South Hamilton local scholarships must be submitted by tax day. The applications have all been shared with students.

FEBRUARY CHECKLIST FOR JUNIORS

- Research careers at www.ihaveaplaniowa.org and complete your guideway
- Become familiar with the FAFSA.
- Make sure you enroll in senior classes that fulfill the credits you need for college.
- Put together a resume listing your activities, volunteer experiences, academic achievements, and employment and submit to Mrs. Gelder.

Registration for 2021-22 school year

All students will register for classes using the Infinite Campus portal before spring break. 9-11 graders should review their four-year plans to see what courses are necessary for graduation and entrance to post-secondary education. All students have plans in their I Have a Plan Iowa Guideways, which can be found at www.ihaveaplaniowa.org. There is a practice sheet for students to complete. After registration is entered online, students must get a parent signature indicating approval of courses. The 2021-22 schedule will be built around these requests, so students should take selections seriously.

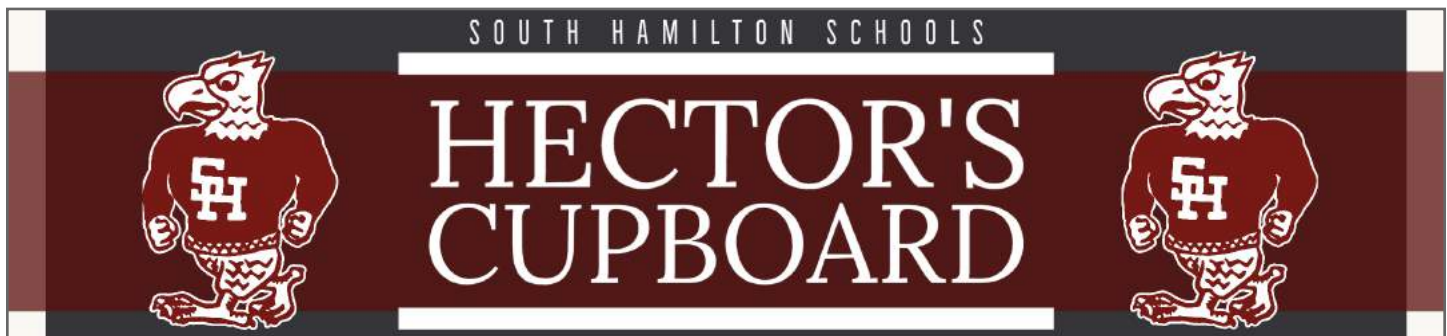


21-22 ENROLLMENT

OPEN ENROLLMENT DEADLINE

The deadline for open enrollment applications for the 2021-2022 school year is March 1, 2022 for grades 1-12 students. The date for kindergarten and preschool special education students is September 1, 2022. The open enrollment applications and athletic eligibility and transportation assistance information may be obtained from the district office or on-line at www.educateiowa.gov (select the A to Z Index Tab; then letter O; Open Enrollment). The Iowa Law requires an application for each child in a family requesting open enrollment and the form must be filed with both the resident and receiving districts on/or before deadline in order to be considered for approval. *Iowa Code 282.18(2) If you have any questions or need more information, please call the district office at 515-827-5479.

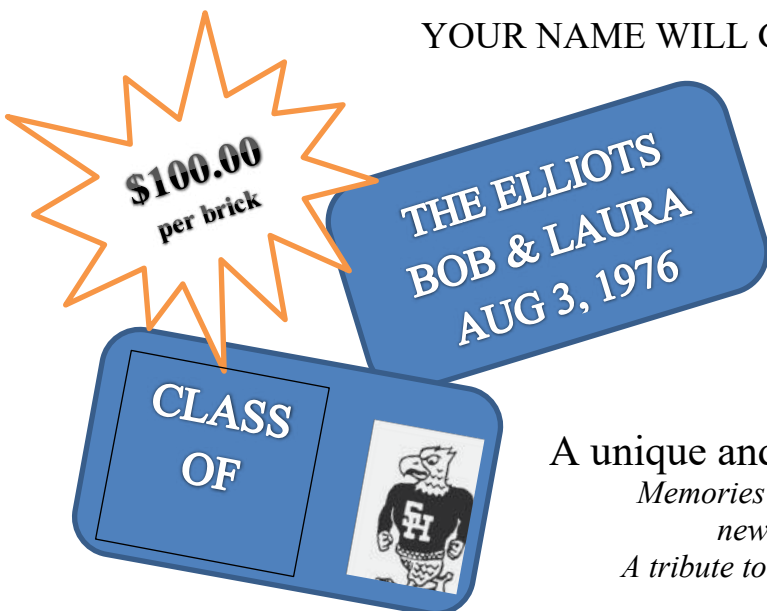

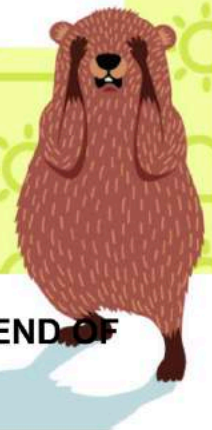
